Overview

"Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light." Genesis 1:2-3

"For God is not a God of disorder but of peace." I Corinthians 14:33 Peace refers to wholeness, order!

Moses said to the whole Israelite community, "This is what the LORD has commanded: <sup>5</sup> From what you have, take an offering for the LORD. Everyone who is willing is to bring to the LORD an offering of gold, silver and bronze; <sup>6</sup> blue, purple and scarlet yarn and fine linen; goat hair; <sup>7</sup> ram skins dyed red and hides of sea cows; acacia wood; <sup>8</sup> olive oil for the light; spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense; <sup>9</sup> and onyx stones and other gems to be mounted on the ephod and breast piece.

I. All Service is a Calling and Is Spiritual.

They are "chosen" (vs. 30) They are "filled with the Spirit of God" (vs. 31)

<sup>...&</sup>lt;sup>30</sup> Then Moses said to the Israelites, "See, the LORD has chosen Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, <sup>31</sup> and he has filled him with the Spirit of God, with skill, ability and knowledge in all kinds of crafts — <sup>32</sup> to make artistic designs for work in gold, silver and bronze, <sup>33</sup> to cut and set stones, to work in wood and to engage in all kinds of artistic craftsmanship. <sup>34</sup> And he has given both him and Oholiab son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan, the ability to teach others. <sup>35</sup> He has filled them with skill to do all kinds of work as craftsmen, designers, embroiderers in blue, purple and scarlet yarn and fine linen, and weavers—all of them master craftsmen and designers.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>36:1</sup> So Bezalel, Oholiab and every skilled person to whom the LORD has given skill and ability to know how to carry out all the work of constructing the sanctuary are to do the work just as the LORD has commanded."

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Then Moses summoned Bezalel and Oholiab and every skilled person to whom the LORD had given ability and who was willing to come and do the work. <sup>3</sup> They received from Moses all the offerings the Israelites had brought to carry out the work of constructing the sanctuary. And the people continued to bring freewill offerings morning after morning. Exodus 35:4-10, 30 – Exodus 36:3

## The Journey: Called to Serve Exodus 35:4-10, 30 – Exodus 36:3

"See, the LORD has chosen Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, and he has filled him with the Spirit of God, with skill, ability and knowledge in all kinds of crafts — And he has given both him and Oholiab son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan, the ability to teach others. (vs. 30 – 31, 34)

"Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it." I Corinthians 12:27. "There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work." (vss. 4-6) "Now if the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? But in fact, God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. (vss. 15-18)

II. Everyone is Called to Serve.

"But you are a chosen people (We are all called into the ministry), a royal priesthood..." I Peter 2:9

"This is what the LORD has commanded: From what you have, take an offering for the LORD. Everyone who is willing is to bring to the LORD an offering of gold, silver and bronze; blue, purple and scarlet yarn and fine linen; goat hair; ram skins dyed red and hides of sea cows; acacia wood; olive oil for the light; spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense; and onyx stones and other gems to be mounted on the ephod and breast piece. (vss. 4-9)

"So all the skilled craftsmen who were doing all the work on the sanctuary left their work and said to Moses, 'The people are bringing more than enough for doing the work the LORD commanded to be done.'

"Then Moses gave an order and they sent this word throughout the camp: 'No man or woman is to make anything else as an offering for the sanctuary' And so the people were restrained from bringing more, because what they already had was more than enough to do all the work." Exodus 36:4-7
