²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another. ²⁵ They exchanged the truth about God for a lie and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen.

II. Look Within!

["]For although they knew God..." (vs. 20)

"I always lived as if there was a God even though I kept telling myself there was no God. The British media tells us that only stupid people believe in God. The truth is materialistic atheism (That's the belief that the only thing that exists is this material world) is a totally irrational creed that people believe without any critical analysis.
